PRE-TRIAL MOVE UPS may be made until 11:59 PM EDT on Monday, November 18, 2024. Day-to-day move-ups will be allowed and must be made before the close of the show on Saturday. Pre-trial move-up requests must be submitted in writing to the Trial Secretary by US mail or email. NO telephone move-ups. Move-up requests must include the Owner/Handler name, name of the dog, AKC Registration number, email address, class(es) entered, and move-up class(es). Move-up confirmations will be sent by email only. You must supply a valid email address to receive confirmation. If you don't receive a reply, your move-up request was not received. The Trial Secretary is not responsible for undelivered move-up requests.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. The club will refund the entry fee, less the \$10.00 processing fee, for any bitch reported to be in season no later than one-half hour before the start of the trial. Any bitch excused because she is found to be "so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element" will not receive a refund.

PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 2024, at 11:30 PM EDT, unless limits are reached before this date. Entry form changes, additions, corrections, and cancellations **MUST** be received in writing or via e-mail before the closing of entries and must include AKC number and breed of dog.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show committee.

MAKE CHECKS and money orders payable to SJVAC, INC. (returned check charge \$20.00). All checks must have scent work class entered written on the face. **THIRD-PARTY CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS**, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of the front and back will be accepted if legible and of official AKC size. A single-entry form may only be used for both days if the information is the same. To use the enclosed entry form, check the appropriate boxes for each show you wish to enter your dog.

ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT SIGNATURE, FEES AND BACK OF ENTRY FORM WITH AGREEMENT, nor will credit cards be accepted. All entries

must be submitted with checks drawn on US Institutions or with International Money Orders in US Funds. Overnight or express mail entries THIRD-PARTY signature permitting delivery without recipient signature.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

- This trial will be conducted under the COVID-19 protocols in effect on the trial dates.
- This event will be conducted following the AKC regulations for Scent Work. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to familiarize themselves with these regulations.
- No indoor crating spaces.
- Exhibitors must pick up after their dog(s).
- No Bitches in season in the building.
- The show site is handicapped-accessible.
- Indoor restroom facilities are available and are handicapped accessible. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors.
- No space is provided for un-entered dogs.
- Free parking.
- Please silence cell phones and pagers before entering the building.
- The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready when it is to be judged.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the judge's opinion, the dog displays no physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate; aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of the search area(s).

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class. In the Handler's Briefing, the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, the number of hides, the maximum height of hides, and the maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

A **warm-up area** will be available. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team before their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search areas may be of any shape and of size specified in the Regulations for each class.

Search Area Conditions. Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces or on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

WAIVER OF RIGHTS

All persons attending this dog show/event hereby waive any claim for damages against St. Joe Valley Agility Club or its member in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

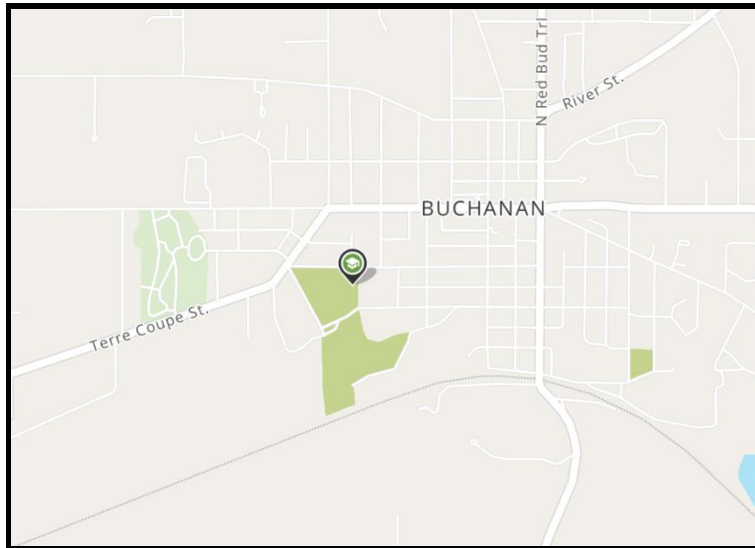

From West: (From New Buffalo, MI) I-94 to Exit 4A, US 12 East to Bakertown Rd. (approximately five miles east of Galien.) Turn left (north) on Bakertown. Go north one mile to Terre Coupe Rd and turn right. Go 0.9 miles and turn slight right onto W. Chicago St. The Buchanan High School Campus will be on the right in 0.2 miles.

From North, South & East: Take US 31 / 20 Bypass to Exit 7, Walton Rd, turn right upon exit. Go west approximately 2.5 miles to River St. and keep left. Turn left (south) onto Red Bud Trail for .03 miles. Turn right onto E. Front St. Turn left onto S. Detroit St in 0.2 miles. Turn right onto W. Chicago St and the Buchanan High School Campus will be on the left.
