Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a vet or judge, or barred from competition by action of show committee.

Bitches in season and bitches with an Ovarian Sparing Spay are permitted to compete. When checking in, you must notify the host club that you have a bitch in season. They will run last in their respective competitions, and may NOT use the same area of the grounds for exercise. A specific location will be marked for bitches in season

If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, lightning, tornadoes or extreme heat must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. In the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refunds will be made.

UKC and ECHO are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or unprescribed drugs will be allowed on the grounds, or while participating in the events, or in the building the day of a UKC Licensed Event.

### Registry

A UKC registration number is desired to participate in these trials. For information on UKC registrations go to [www.ukcdogs.com](http://www.ukcdogs.com). Non-UKC Registered Dog Fee – A \$5 additional fee will be assessed to dogs not Temporarily Listed, Performance Listed, or Permanently Registered with UKC. This fee will be forwarded to the UKC with the Event recording fees. Participants whose dogs pass or place have 60 days in which to complete the registration application to UKC. ### Refunds

Participants may request a full refund before the closing date. After the closing date no refunds will be issued.

### Substitution Policy

Once a team is notified they are entered, the handler may substitute another dog at the same level.

### Trial Information:

- **ALL** ranges will be **CLOSED** until the last dog has run for the day.
- The trials will be run on field and forest courses. Bring your waterproof boots and insect repellent!
- The Club requests a limit of 3 dogs per handler.
- Camping on the club grounds will be available Friday and Saturday night for free. Contact the Trial Secretary for additional info.
- Confirmation emails will be sent to exhibitors.
- Dogs must be checked in at least 15 minutes before running time.

### Trial Info continued:

- It is your responsibility to clean up after your dog. Anyone observed not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave. No refunds.
- Lunch break will be determined by the Judges.
- ECHO Club, Inc. reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Spectators are welcome. Conversation is acceptable, but DO NOT give the hide away! No dogs in viewing area.
- There will be hot breakfast for sale in the clubhouse on Sunday morning from 8:00 until 12:00, COVID protocols permitting!
- If you wish to use the ranges while you are at the trial, the guest fee is \$6. Ranges will re-open once all dogs have run.

### Directions to Show Site:

#### **From East or West:**

Take I-94 to Coloma exit, Exit 39.  
Turn LEFT at top of exit ramp.  
Go to first cross street, Mountain Rd. and turn LEFT.  
Go to first intersection, Angling Rd. and turn LEFT. This intersection is a "T" intersection.  
Coloma Rod and Gun Club is at the dead end of Angling Rd on the RIGHT.  
Follow the signs to check-in.
